

Target Re-allocation Methodology

NSDC will be considering below parameters and do the due-diligence before proceeding for re-allocation of targets to the requested job role. The training centre will be required to fill the application (application 1) appended at the end of this note and send to targetspmky@nsdcindia.org

The reallocation process will be done job role wise for a centre and not centre as a whole. Any job role wherein a centre has started training for 100% of the allocated target and training has been completed for 75% of the allocated target for that particular job role.

This process of re-allocation will be completed within maximum 15 working days of request provided it qualifies.

Eligibility Criteria of a Training centre to receive re-allocations:

1. Training Centre should have complied to AEBAS guidelines(except in NE states and J&K)
2. Request for re-allocation can be made once the last batch of the requested re-allocation in the job role is enrolled as per SDMS
3. The center should be a TP Owned centre with 4 or 5 star rating on SMART (3 star center to be considered in NE, J&K and TCs applying for Agriculture job role)
4. The center should have scored at least 5 marks (i.e. min 40% placement percentage for certified candidates) against the parameter no. 3 in 'Scoring Matrix for Re-allocation' table below.

Training centres under various categories like PMKKs, Railways, Army, SCPwD-TCs, etc. Will be re-allocated as per the guidelines of respective category.

Training centres will be considered for Re-allocation for period ending 31st March, 2018

Scoring Matrix for Re-allocation:

* In case training is completed and Assessment/Certification is pending at SSC, TCs are requested to fill the application post completion of assessment/Certification, as any pendency may impact the reflection of performance in the requested job role.

**The criteria for monitoring reporting based on different parameters is explained below:

Centers where surprise visit has not been conducted under PMKVY 2.0, only the remaining applicable parameters will be considered while calculating the performance score.

Basis the scores from the above scoring matrix, following will be the actions to be taken on the reallocation requests:

1. TCs scoring 70% or above in saturated states (Punjab, Haryana, Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan & Madhya Pradesh) and 60% or above in unsaturated states are eligible for 100% of actual available capacity or requested capacity (whichever is less)
2. TCs scoring 50% or above in saturated states (Punjab, Haryana, Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan & Madhya Pradesh) and 40% or above in unsaturated states are eligible for 85% of actual available capacity or requested capacity (whichever is less)
3. TCs scoring less than 50% in saturated states (Punjab, Haryana, Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan & Madhya Pradesh) and less than 40% in unsaturated states are not eligible for Re-Allocation. Special cases might be evaluated on case to case basis for consideration under Re-allocation

Please Note:

- In addition to the above, the following parameters will be considered
 - Average count of Kaushal Mela / RozgarMela organized
 - Credibility / community development activities in local vicinity
 - Activities conducted with elected representatives
- This Application can only be submitted by TCs having already allocated targets in any job role under PMKVY 2016-2020
- Training Centre should fill the details correctly in the attached application, as any wrong information may lead to rejection of application
- If application is successfully processed and targets are allotted in requested job role/job roles, then TC will not be eligible for submission of any further reallocation application in the requested job role/job roles till 31st March 2018
