**Notice regarding Shortlisting of Proposals submitted under PMKVY 2016-20 RFP**

The PMKVY RFP was published on [www.pmkvyofficial.org](http://www.pmkvyofficial.org) on 31<sup>st</sup> July 2018, with the eventual outcome of allocating target for certifying around 2 lakh candidates to training providers and institutions under Short Term Training -CSCM component of PMKVY 2016-20. The aim of providing target via the RFP route is to promote high quality educational institutions, government training intuitions, reputed philanthropic organizations, not for profit organizations, new training providers, who have not been associated with PMKVY 2016- 18. This RFP also considered the existing PMKVY centres which have successfully conducted trainings in particular priority districts and geographies but may not be eligible for reallocation due to lack of benchmarked performance levels. Proposals aims to bring in ITI's, NGO, startup or other agencies working in aspirational and underserved district (Annexure 19.4, 19.5 of RFP) especially with marginalized community. RFP mode aims to also uniformly distribute targets across regions and geography based on aspirational district combination for wider skilling outreach.

The proposals were submitted by applicants through online mode for which the last date was 02<sup>nd</sup> September 2018.

### **1. Shortlisting of submitted Proposals**

Ensuring the geographical distribution leading to sector/state balance, the target allocation methodology will be based on state wise targets available. Rank of a proposal as per the evaluation matrix would be considered for allocation of target. Preference will be given to the following parameters (non- exhaustive) while allocating targets as mentioned in [http://pmkvyofficial.org/App Documents/News/PMKVY-RFP-Corrigendum-Final-27\\_08\\_2018.pdf](http://pmkvyofficial.org/App Documents/News/PMKVY-RFP-Corrigendum-Final-27_08_2018.pdf) :

- Aspirational districts (Annexure – 19.5 as per RFP)
- Underserve districts (Annexure – 19.4 as per RFP)
- Demand of proposed sector and Job Roles
- Total training capacity and available capacity for skill training
- Apprenticeship enabled training proposed (refer annexure 19.6 as per RFP)
- Government recognized award to the promoter/ director or the company
- Institutional rating from NAAC, UGC/AICTE etc.
- Geographical distribution leading to sector/state balance
- State wise targets available

### **District Classification for Shortlisting of submitted proposals for target allocation**

To ensure geographical distribution, and presence in districts across the country, all the districts have been classified into various district types with preference to be given to districts according to the following three gradients:

Aspirational District (List of districts available in the published RFP), Districts with no previous allocations under CSCM STT PMKVY 2016-20, and Districts with no PMKK centre. The details are mentioned below:

District Type 6	Non-Aspirational District, No PMKVY & PMKK Present
District Type 7	Aspirational District, PMKVY Present & PMKK Present
District Type 8	Non-Aspirational District, PMKVY Present & PMKK Present

## **2. Major Parameters of prospective allocation – Phase 1 allocations**

### *To ensure geographical spread and distribution across partners*

- 2.1. Capping of 360 per Training Center with maximum of 120 per job role for this FY 2018-19
- 2.2. For district type 1 & 2 there would be capping of 2000 per district
- 2.3. For district type 3 to 8 there would be capping of 1200 per district
- 2.4. Targets will be allocated to maximum 10 centers per TP/Organization across the country.
- 2.5. Targets will be allocated to maximum 1 center per TP in a particular district.
- 2.6. For district type 1 and 2, both existing (PMKVY & Non-PMKVY) and proposed centres would be considered for target allocation.
- 2.7. For district type 3 to 8 only existing (PMKVY & Non-PMKVY) training centers would be considered for target allocation.

## **3. Steps in shortlisting of proposals**

- 3.1. The shortlisting of proposals will start from districts falling in district type 1 moving to district type 8 which is in the order of priority and would continue till all the targets have been exhausted.
- 3.2. Within a district type, preference would be given to unsaturated districts (As per STT- CSCM (PMKVY 2016-20) data.
- 3.3. Shortlisting of all proposals in Category 1 to be done
- 3.4. For each district for all three remaining categories i.e. Category 2, Category 3, and Category 4; Training Centre shortlisting would take place as per above mentioned guidelines and Proposals evaluation parameters mentioned in section 6 (Evaluation Process) and 7 (Ranking of Proposal) in the PMKVY RFP.

This shortlisting is tentative and may differ as per the outcome of due diligence of proposals and other factors. TPs may not be allocated target under all the proposed job roles as preference/priority has been given to apprenticeship /unsaturated job roles.

Due Diligence will be conducted only for the Training Partners that will be shortlisted for at least one training centre as per the methodology mentioned above. The shortlisted training partners would be notified on PMKVY Website. Upon completion of this exercise, the review will be done, and updates would be notified.
